Footnotes

CANULETMEDOWNEASY stalked off the rail then inside into the turn, came out leaving the turn, bid three deep into the stretch to gain the lead, kicked clear under urging and held. MY SUMMER SLEW had speed outside then stalked off the rail, angled in on the turn, swung out into the stretch, continued under left handed urging in the drive, had the rider lose the whip a sixteenth out but finished willingly. CLUBHOUSE RIDE saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and bested the rest. L. A. WEEKEND dueled between horses then outside a rival on the turn, continued between foes into the stretch and weakened. MALIBU KNIGHT bobbled then was squeezed back at the start, settled off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and found his best stride late. TRUEST LEGEND had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn but weakened in the stretch. BATTI MAN (ARG) dueled between horses, dropped back and lugged out on the turn, angled in some nearing the stretch and also weakened. RED JAG pressed the pace four wide, dropped back and was forced out on the turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and also weakened.
