MEINERTZHAGENI squeezed at the start, chased outside then alongside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied while drifting in some under left handed urging to gain the lead a sixteenth out and proved best. KANTINA KOWGIRL stalked a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out some in the stretch and wore down the pacesetter late for the place. MISS LOUJEAN sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, inched away leaving the turn, kicked clear, could match the winner in the final sixteenth and just lost second. WRITER FEVER broke a bit slowly then steadied when squeezed after the start, settled off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and improved position. SINGLEINTHELAST also a step slow to begin, steadied in the opening strides between horses, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, came out in upper stretch and lacked a rally. NATIVE EMPRESS saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn then angled back in and also did not rally. CAL GAL bumped at the start, stalked outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. MY AUNT ANNIE also bumped at the start, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn and lacked a response in the lane. GOOD PROOF broke in and bumped the winner, had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, had that one get away leaving the turn, dropped back in the stretch and weakened.
