Footnotes

BAGSHOT angled in entering the first turn and saved ground unhurried, went around a rival then moved up inside on the second turn, came out in upper stretch and surged to the front three deep in midstretch, then drew clear under a brisk hand ride and was taken under a hold late. MUSICAL GAMBLER three deep between foes early, angled in and dueled inside to midstretch, was no match for the winner but held second. SKY JACK bobbled a the start, pulled his way up four wide into the first turn, dueled outside the runner-up, battled between horses in midstretch, also was no match for the winner but saved the show. SCOOP OF ICE bumped at the start and steadied off heels in the run to the first turn, settled off the rail, came out some into the stretch and lacked the needed late response. RIGHT REVVED allowed to settle outside, went three deep on the second turn and failed to respond. HIGH WIRE ACT bumped at the start, pulled his way along between horses early, settled outside a rival, drifted out on the second turn, gave way and was not urged in the stretch. CHARLEY MC chased along the inside, dropped back into the second turn, then also gave way and was eased.
