AIN'T IT SWEEP quickly sped to the front, set all the pace inside, inched away in the stretch and proved best under urging. COMPOSURE sent between horses to stalk the pace, continued off the rail on the turn and into the stretch, loomed a threat in midstretch and held second. POINT CLEAR well placed tracking the winner three deep then outside the runner-up on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and was edged for the place. SKEENA wide early, settled off the rail then outside on the backstretch, angled in alongside a rival on the turn and was not a threat. HEART THAT MATTERS broke in and bumped a foe, chased inside on the backstretch and into the turn, came around a rival leaving the bend and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. PRETTY MEADOW angled in and stalked the winner along the inside but weakened in the stretch. GO YOYO bumped at the start, settled inside, had a rail trip and failed to menace. ANNAGRETA off a bit slowly and bumped between horses to fall back at the start, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn and was outrun.
