DENIED had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away leaving the second turn, fought back inside in the stretch, came out under left handed urging nearing the wire, bumped with DESIGNED FOR LUCK and held on gamely. DESIGNED FOR LUCK pulled his way along inside to stalk the pace, inched forward into and on the second turn, waited off heels leaving that bend, came out into the stretch, drifted in a bit in deep stretch then was bumped and steadied nearing the wire. MOUNTAIN RAGE off a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside on the second turn, came out in the stretch and gained the show. LORD JIM (ARG) chased a bit off the rail then outside a rival leaving the backstretch, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. REEL 'EM IN pulled his way up four wide early then pressed the pace three deep and weakened in the stretch. WOODEN PHONE had good early speed and set a pressured pace between horses, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. Following a stewards' inquiry, DENIED was disqualified and placed second for interference in late stretch.
