COAL REGION KID stalked outside, bid three deep leaving the turn, took the lead alongside the pacesetter into the stretch and drew clear under some urging and steady handling. ROYAL HEAT stalked off the rail or between horses, continued off the inside on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch,

drifted in some in the drive but was second best. DOUGHBOY settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out in upper stretch and edged the pacesetter for the show. DETECTIVE POIROT sped between horses to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, was no match for top pair in the final furlong and was edged for third. CRESTON COWBOY chased off the rail or between foes, entered the stretch alongside a rival and lacked the needed rally. QUIETLY WAITING between horses early, angled in and chased inside thereafter and could not offer the necessary response. MUDROYALE broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled just off the inside, swung out into the stretch and was not a threat. LAST CAPER dropped back outside early, settled off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and did not rally. ONEBADBOY went up inside to stalk the pace, continued a bit off the rail on the turn and between horses passing the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. SUZURAN DANCER allowed to settle outside then off the rail, angled in some for the turn and was not a factor. WHAT A GOLDMINE stalked a bit off the rail, dropped back just off the fence then between foes on the turn and gave way. OUR INSTIGATOR settled outside then off the rail, dropped back on the turn, drifted out into the stretch and was through early.
