### Footnotes

**DYNAMIC DIVA** wide early, angled in and settled outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under some left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch, drifted out some late but proved best. **DAZZLETOWN** three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival then three wide leaving the second turn, came four wide into the stretch, gained the advantage, inched away in midstretch, fought back between foes in deep stretch and held second. **CEE'S THE YEAR** angled in and stalked inside, came out into the stretch, split horses in midstretch, bid off the rail in deep stretch and bested the others. **KIT CAT KITTY** angled in and settled a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out in the stretch, waited off heels in midstretch, split horses in deep stretch and improved position. **WARREN'S CITY ART** pulled her way along to stalk the pace inside, waited behind rivals leaving the turn and when coming out into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed rally. **SHESKEY** had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch, then weakened. **MISS CALIFORNIA** dueled outside a rival then between horses leaving the second turn, continued between foes in midstretch and also weakened. **QUIET ADVICE** wide between foes early, angled in and settled a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and did not rally. **ROYAL CHAVELA** three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, bid three wide leaving the second turn and into the stretch, then weakened.
