SUNRAY SPIRIT broke clean and had good early speed, responded when challenged mid way on the turn, dug in gamely when asked in mid stretch and held under steady urging. REQUESTO tracked the pace to the turn, raced three wide and loomed a factor into the stretch, was outfished by the winner but finished best of the rest. TIMELY ACTION was allowed to settle, rallied four wide to the stretch and finished a no threat third. SMART CHIP tracked the pace from the inside to the turn, remained a factor to mid stretch then had could not keep up and finished evenly. FROM A TO Z showed good early speed, pressed the pace two wide to the turn but tired in the drive. STRIKING SONG was allowed to settle to the half, got fanned five wide to the stretch and lacked the necessary closing response. WILD CELEBRATION had no speed and could not muster a finishing kick. VOWEL PLAY hesitated and broke a step slow, was slow to settle and did not reach contention. MANONTHEMOVE was very wide throughout and showed little.
