FINANCIAL between foes early, pressed the pace inside, had the runner-up slip away leaving the second turn, came out and re-bid outside that rival, took a short lead into the stretch and gamely prevailed under some urging. GLOBAL EMPIRE stalked a bit off the rail, came out on the backstretch and bid four wide a half mile out, continued outside the winner, inched away and angled in leaving the second turn, fought back inside the winner in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. DBL OTT stalked the pace inside, continued inside in the stretch and edged a rival for third. ARCHIE'S DREAM saved ground chasing the pace, came a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, steadied off heels a quarter mile out, came out in the stretch and missed the show. DESTINYS ISLAND bobbed and was off a bit slowly, settled off the rail, angled in on the second turn and improved position but was not a threat. LES'S LEGACY also off a bit slowly, chased outside, went three deep on the second turn and failed to menace. COLD MARKET pulled a bit early, stalked outside, bid three deep between foes to put a head in front briefly a half mile out, dropped back on the second turn and had little left. RADIO CAROLINE chased off the rail, also fell back on the second turn and weakened. PROSPECTOR'S SON four wide early, angled in three deep then dueled outside a rival on the first turn and backstretch, was between foes a half mile out, gave way readily and was eased in the stretch.
