BEHAVING BADLY had good early speed and dueled inside a rival on the backstretch, eased back a bit into the turn and bid outside that foe, gained the advantage in upper stretch and gamely prevailed under urging. FREAKIN STREAKIN broke inward and bobbled, settled inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. DEE DEE'S DINER angled in and dueled outside the winner, inched away and angled in leaving the backstretch, dueled inside on the turn, drifted off the rail into the stretch, fought back in the lane and held third. MINI SKIRT chased outside a rival then between foes, angled in on the turn and lacked the needed late kick. RINKY DINK (AUS) stalked the pace outside then three deep into and on the turn and weakened in the stretch. PUXA SACO off a bit awkwardly, settled off the rail then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and did not rally. RESPLENDENCY stalked off the rail on the backstretch and between horses on the turn and weakened in the stretch. NINADIVINA settled inside chasing the pace, remained along the rail and failed to menace.
