Footnotes

STUDENT COUNCIL stalked the pace inside then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, bid four wide leaving the second turn, took the lead into the stretch, kicked clear under urging, drifted out in the final furlong but held gamely. AWESOME GEM chased inside then off the rail into the backstretch, ranged up four wide into the stretch and finished well to just miss. HELLO SUNDAY (FR) pulled his way along and angled in early, stalked off the rail, bid alongside the pacesetter on the backstretch and into the second turn, put a head in front between foes leaving that turn, continued inside in the stretch and held third. ARSON SQUAD chased outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and had a mild bid. BIG BOOSTER settled outside a rival then off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and was not a threat. LAVA MAN stalked inside then outside a rival on the first turn and backstretch, bid three deep on the second turn and between horses a quarter mile out and weakened in the stretch. PORFIDO (CHI) pulled between horses early then

angled in and saved ground off the pace and did not rally. ALBERTUS MAXIMUS between horses early, stalked outside a rival then inside, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. A. P. XCELLENT wide early, took the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the backstretch and second turn, dropped back into the stretch and also weakened. TIME SQUARED pulled early, angled in and chased outside a rival then along the inside, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. SALTY HUMOR a bit awkwardly into stride, settled off the pace outside a rival then angled in on the second turn and failed to menace. SUN BOAT (GB) saved ground off the pace, dropped well back on the second turn, came out into the stretch, gave way and was eased in the drive.
