CALIFORNIA FLAG bobbled slightly at the start, had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away into the stretch and held on gamely under left handed urging. DELTA STORM stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out some in midstretch and went willingly to the wire alongside the winner. TENGA CAT had speed three deep early, stalked off the rail then a bit off the fence, came out in the stretch and edged a rival for third. STONESIDE (IRE) was in a good position stalking the pace inside to the stretch, remained along the rail and was edged for the show. GET FUNKY settled off the rail then angled in, came out into the stretch and split rivals with a late bid at a minor award. BAMAHA BREEZE had speed between horses then dueled outside the winner, was between foes again past midstretch and weakened. CANDY PULL stalked four wide then outside, went three deep leaving the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. EUROGLIDE allowed to settle outside then chased alongside a rival and lacked a response in the stretch.
