Footnotes

IT'S NOT UNUSUAL was between horses around the first turn, chased on the inside down the backstretch, awaited room in midstretch, got through along the rail and rallied on the wood to gain the score. ABSOLUTLYPOSITIVLY chased on the inside around the first turn, was between horses on the backstretch, angled out three wide entering the stretch, rallied and was a clear second at the wire. SKIMMING SKIPPER was three deep into the first turn, opened up a clear lead leaving that turn, maintained the advantage to the lane and gave way grudgingly in the final furlong while holding third at the wire. NOBLE CAVALIER was bumped shortly after the start, pulled in the run around the first turn, settled down the backstretch, swung out for the stretch drive and improved his position. KIM'S LEADING MAN was bumped shortly after the start, was between horses around the first turn, pulled his way along to press the pace to the top of the lane and weakened in the final furlong. ISLAND SUNSET was reserved into the first turn, moved up on the backstretch to chase outside a three horse spread, remained three deep on the second turn and weakened down the lane. TUNASITY was inside around the first turn, began to fall back on the backstretch and could not muster a bid thereafter.
