Footnotes

NOT IN THIS LIFE had speed between horses to force then stalk the pace, continued off the rail on the turn and into the stretch, bid under urging outside

the pacesetter in deep stretch and got up late. THE PHENOM broke out and bumped a rival, was sent along then pulled between horses to duel for the lead, inched away and angled in on the turn, fought back in deep stretch and was edged late. GRAND MANEUVER broke in a bit, was bumped between horses early, chased between foes then off the rail, continued outside on the turn and five wide into the stretch and finished with interest outside the top pair. TIGER TRYSTS bumped early then was sent between horses to force or stalk the pace, continued off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and bested the others. DESTINED JOURNEY unhurried outside then off the rail on the backstretch and turn, swung six wide into the stretch and found his best stride late. CONFER bumped early, settled off the rail, angled in on the turn, swung out and steadied off heels three deep then four wide into the stretch and improved position. SNETTISHAM chased between horses then off the rail, was in a bit tight off heels leaving the turn and did not rally. RENEWING broke slowly, settled inside, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. SPRING CALL had speed between horses to duel for the lead, stalked between foes on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. SI ES VERDAD had speed four wide between horses, stalked outside, continued four wide on the turn, angled in some into the stretch and also weakened. RAPALLO close up six wide early, stalked outside, went four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. MANDELIEU had good early speed and dueled inside then stalked along the rail, was shuffled back into the turn, continued inside and had little left for the stretch.
