SIREN LURE unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, advanced four wide on the turn, continued off the inside into the stretch and rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and won clear. PURE AS GOLD sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled outside a rival, kicked clear on the turn, could not hold off the winner but saved the place. AREYOUTALKINTOME saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside in the stretch and bested the others. BATTLE WON chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TRICKEY TREVOR dueled inside the runner-up but a bit off the rail, found the fence into the turn, dropped back leaving the turn, was between horses into the stretch and weakened. YES HE'S A PISTOL chased between horses early, dropped back a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn and had little left. DECLAN'S MOON stalked outside then four wide on the backstretch and three deep into the turn, dropped back leaving the turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
