LAVA MAN pulled his way along early, dueled inside, kicked clear midway on the second turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and proved best under urging while drifting in some in the drive. GOOD REWARD angled in and chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, moved up inside leaving the second turn and into the stretch, came out in midstretch and held second. SUPER FROLIC stalked outside a rival, bid four wide on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and was edged for the place. PERFECT DRIFT chased off the rail then outside, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. GIACOMO a step slow to begin, chased off the inside then three deep on the first turn, continued outside a rival on the backstretch, went between horses on the second turn, angled to the inside into the stretch and did not rally. TOP THIS AND THAT saved ground off the pace, came out a bit in the stretch and was not a threat. MAGNUM (ARG) stalked the pace off the rail, split rivals three deep with a bid on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and weakened. PREACHINATTHEBAR dueled outside the winner, dropped back leaving the second turn, was between horses into the stretch and also weakened.
