Footnotes

HOCKEYTHEHAYMAN stalked the pace off the rail, split horses leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid between foes under some urging past midstretch to gain the lead and proved best. TEAMWORK chased outside a rival, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes past midstretch, could not match the winner late but bested the others. GOING FORWARD pulled his way along to stalk the pace outside a rival then off the rail on the turn, bid between horses past midstretch and held third. NO PRODIGAL pulled on the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, drifted in nearing midstretch, fought back in the final furlong and weakened some late. COMPLEXITY chased inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out some in the stretch and split horses late. MY SUMMER SLEW stalked the pace along the rail, waited off heels in midstretch, came out for room in deep stretch and went between rivals late. DON'T FORGET MUQ chased off the rail on the backstretch and outside leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary response. SWISS SKI dropped back off the rail early, angled in leaving the backstretch, rode the rail on the turn and into the stretch and was not a threat.
