**Footnotes**

LOOKING FOR CANDY chased outside a rival, split horses on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and held gamely. SINGLE SHOT chased inside, steadied off heels leaving the turn, came out around a rival into the stretch, split horses in midstretch and again late with a good finish. SYLLABUS steadied at the start then was bumped between horses in the opening strides, settled outside, came out five wide into the stretch and closed willingly late. HARLAN'S TUNE sent between horses to force the pace, stalked a bit off the rail on the turn, found the inside into the stretch and was outfinished. SALAH SALAH dueled between horses then outside a rival, inched away leaving the turn, kicked clear off the rail in the stretch and weakened some late. NIGHT JUSTICE hopped in a slow start, settled inside, split horses on the turn, came out three deep into the stretch and could not quite summon the necessary final kick. SEA VIPER broke in onto a rival, prompted the pace outside then four wide, stalked on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. MINISTER MACHINE bumped early, pulled his way between horses to force the pace, stalked on the turn, drifted inward in the stretch and also weakened. EL NAVIGANTE had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, dropped back leaving the turn, came out in the stretch, gave way and was eased in the final furlong.
