EXUMA saved ground chasing the pace, moved up into the stretch, bid along the rail past the eighth pole, put a head in front in deep stretch, drifted out and gamely prevailed under urging. BELL BLITZ sent between horses to the early lead, angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, dueled on the second turn, came out some into the stretch, fought back between horses through the final furlong, drifted out late and continued gamely to the wire. LE' HEAT pulled inside and was in a bit tight off heels into the first turn, came a bit off the rail to stalk the pace, bid alongside the runner-up on the second turn, came out some into the stretch, gained the advantage in midstretch, also drifted out late and continued willingly but was outgamed. REGROUP between foes early, angled in and stalked inside, came out for room leaving the second turn and into the stretch, waited off heels from midstretch to deep stretch, angled in late and was outfinished. MONEY INCLUDED three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch, bid outside in the drive and could not quite summon the necessary late kick. THE HUNT IS ON chased three deep, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BRASS PLATE settled between horses chasing the pace, came out three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response.
