SWEET SWAP went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the turn, fought off the bid of a rival in the stretch and proved best under some left handed urging. CASTAWAY stalked the pace off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and gained the place late outside foes. TIZ POINT pressed the pace outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, stalked on the turn, bid alongside the winner again into the stretch, could not match that one in the final furlong and was edged for second but saved the show between foes on the line. BLACKY THE BULL a bit slow to begin, went up inside to chase the pace, split horses into the stretch, drifted in late and was outfinished for a minor award. MAY WEATHER bobbled at the start, chased off the rail then between rivals, angled in on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SKY KINGDOM broke slowly, moved up inside on the backstretch and a bit off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. RING IT UP a bit slow to begin, settled outside a rival or off the rail, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. MY BEST BROTHER chased outside, dropped back three deep on the turn and into the stretch and weakened. MR. NEWTON had good early speed a bit off the rail, dueled between horses, stalked on the turn, angled to the inside nearing the stretch and also weakened.
