**SHEDIK (FR)** pulled his way along inside stalking the pace, waited a bit leaving the turn, was in a bit tight off heels into the stretch, bid between foes past midstretch, gained the lead outside the runner-up a sixteenth out and prevailed under some urging. **MASTER CHEF** sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace a bit off the rail, fought back along the fence inside the final furlong and continued willingly. **VALKYRIE MISSILE** chased between horses, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and just got the show. **LORO** chased three deep then four wide into the turn, came three wide into the stretch and was edged for third. **VIA VERDE** settled a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and finished with interest. **CADILLAC COACH** broke a bit slowly and threw his head, went outside a rival on the backstretch, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. **PRINCE INTENT** was in a good position stalking the pace three deep, angled in between horses leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. **DUBBER** angled in and stalked the pace inside to the stretch and also weakened. **CARMICHAEL** pulled his way along to stalk the pace between horses, dropped back leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
