Footnotes

HOLLYCOMBE broke outward and was knocked sideways at the start, had the best speed, responded on the far turn, dug in when set down in upper stretch and gamely drew clear late. SON'S CORONA was bumped hard and squeezed back at the start, lagged for a half, made a bold bid two wide on the second turn, engaged the leaders in upper stretch but finished evenly late. DANCING AFLEET was four wide to the backstretch, rallied on the far turn to loom boldly into the stretch but lugged inward in upper stretch and gave way late. MARCH OF KINGS saved ground but could only pass tiring horses. MARGED'S DANCER stalked the pace to the far turn and weakened. ONE MAN ARMY was just off the leaders while under a snug hold but came up empty when asked on the far turn. KING CRIMSON was bumped at the start and did not reach contention.
