HAVANA TIZZY stalked the early pace a bit off the rail, bid alongside the runner-up on the backstretch and dueled for the lead, gained the advantage in midstretch drew clear under urging. ENERGY CZAR sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner, fought back in midstretch and held second. WALLY WORLD angled in and settled outside a rival, moved up a bit off the rail into the second turn, found the fence into the stretch then came out around a foe late for third. STORMY SURGE stalked off the rail, split horses on the backstretch, angled in leaving the second turn and lost the show late. NORTH AMERICA chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and did not rally. MOHEGAN CHIEF five wide into the first turn, stalked four wide then outside, angled in alongside a rival leaving the second turn and weakened. STRONG FORCE settled inside then came off the rail leaving the backstretch, went outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. RAPID SILVER chased between horses or off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and weakened. TURF TIME pulled his way along between horses and was in a bit tight on the first turn,

chased outside, dropped back and angled in some on the second turn and also weakened. HONOUR ROLL stalked the early pace off the rail, dropped back between foes on the backstretch and gave way.
