CIGAR MAN settled inside then came out on the backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and rallied steadily under good handling to get up late. DIFERENTKINDAGREAT three deep early, angled in and stalked a bit off the rail, bid three deep leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, took a short lead, inched away in midstretch, fought back in deep stretch but was collared late. EL MARTILLO bobbled a bit at the start, chased inside, bid along the rail in the stretch, drifted out some from the whip in deep stretch and bested the others. DEAL BREAKER (GB) chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CAPE TRUTH sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, drifted out into the stretch, was between horses nearing midstretch, then weakened. BOOTED prompted the pace outside a rival, was floated out three deep into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
