Footnotes

SISTER MOON moved up quickly on the inside to assume the early lead, showed the way around the turn, drew away under urging at the top of the stretch, increased her advantage in the final furlong under a strong hand ride and steady handling late. CANDY AND THUNDER bobbed at the start, chased off the rail down the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn, remained inside for the drive and gained the place while no threat to the winner. LADY FAIRBANKS chased on the outside down the backstretch, moved up three deep on the turn, went after the winner leaving the quarter pole, could not keep pace and drifted out late under left handed urging. MOLLY'S ALL HEART chased on the inside into the turn, saved some ground around the turn, came out for the stretch drive and lacked the necessary rally. TREATHERLIKEALADY stalked the pace outside the winner down the backstretch, remained prominent to the quarter pole and weakened in the final furlong. BULLETGIRL veered out and steadied at the start, angled inside down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn and made no impact.
