DONATO pulled hard along the inside then stalked a bit off the rail, bid along the fence in the stretch, gained a short lead past midstretch, came off the rail passing the gap to the chute and held on gamely outside the runner-up under urging. MR. MAKE BELIEVE pulled and steadied between foes leaving the chute, chased inside, came out into the stretch, angled back to the inside in midstretch and closed gamely inside. OAK KYE WHY sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, came off the rail into the second turn, battled outside the winner in the final furlong and continued willingly to save third. OILISBLACKGOLD angled in and chased inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival into the second turn and four wide into the stretch and split horses on the line. TIPPETY TAP TAP settled a bit off the rail, swung out in upper stretch and also went between foes late. ANTIDOTE three deep early, stalked outside a rival then off the rail, split horses into the stretch, continued between foes through much of the drive and was outkicked. RENEGADE STORM unhurried inside then off the rail on the second turn, came out in the stretch and put in a late bid six wide on the line. THEY CALL HIM EL stalked off the rail then inside, came off the fence again in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ROYAL F J bobbled at the start, chased outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary rally.
