Footnotes

DELTA FIX sent between horses early, dueled inside, inched away leaving the turn and drew clear in the stretch under a tap of the whip and steady handling. TOP TORERO angled in and stalked outside or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, drifted in and bested the others. WARRENS WILD THING chased four wide between horses then outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and picked up the show. DISTINCTLY angled in and dueled outside a rival, stalked leaving the turn and weakened in the stretch. YOU LITTLE DEVIL hopped slightly and was off slowly, settled outside then

alongside a rival, came four wide into the stretch and improved position. SLEWS DARK KNIGHT stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened. REGGIANO saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, angled back in and also weakened. BOOMTOWN angled in and stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and had little left for the drive. CHI CHA CHA chased five wide on the backstretch and outside on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. PUSHBACKJACK squeezed at the start, settled off the rail then angled in, steadied and came out around a rival leaving the turn and failed to menace. VALENTINE JOE chased a bit off the rail, dropped back into and on the turn and gave way. JACKSON'S HONOUR settled between horses chasing the pace, dropped back fast on the turn and also gave way.
