Footnotes

FREQUENT FAME stalked inside, split rivals on the turn, angled back in leaving the bend, bid along the fence in the stretch to gain the lead past midstretch, inched away and held under urging. UNKEPT RENDEZ VOUS (FR) chased between horses or a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the turn, came out in midstretch and finished well. LIA JULIANA chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and split rivals for the show. ATTRACTA jsettled outside on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and finished well. THREE CUTIES settled outside then

alongside a rival, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, found the inside in the stretch and was outfinished. RAISIN' CAIN sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SECRET OF SUCCESS stalked between foes early then outside, continued alongside a rival on the turn and lacked the needed rally. LA TORERA chased a bit off the rail, went three deep midway on the turn, angled in some nearing the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. HIP allowed to settle off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and was not a threat. WARREN'S GOLDIE settled off the rail then inside, came out leaving the turn and failed to menace. PINCELADA stalked off the rail, dropped back and angled in on the turn, gave way, was unsaddled at the end of the stretch when bleeding from the nostrils but walked off.
