Footnotes

CLOUDS CLEARING broke in the air and slowly, settled inside chasing the pace, moved up into the stretch, bid between foes under some urging past midstretch, continued inside in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. COMPULSIVE chased a bit off the rail then inside, went four wide leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, came in and bumped a rival in upper stretch, bid outside foes to gain a slim advantage past midstretch, battled outside the winner in deep stretch and was edged late. CINMARS DANCE broke slowly, settled inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and split horses late for the show. ANYTHINGTOGETEVEN saved ground stalking the pace and was in a bit tight on the backstretch, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch and was outfinished late. MOSSO dueled three deep then angled in between horses into the stretch, was bumped in upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SONG OF THE TIMES had good early speed and dueled inside, inched away in midstretch and weakened late. THREE STRIKE RULE chased a bit off the rail or outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SOOO MAJOR chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. SIR BARCLAY angled in and dueled between horses, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. GRIFTERS MARK a bit slow into stride, was pulled up shortly after the start and vanned off.
