FIN LADY broke out onto rivals and was bumped, settled outside a rival then off the rail on the turn, advanced three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in midstretch and pulled clear under steady handling. FULL O' GLEE settled toward the inside, came outside a rival into the stretch and picked up the place late. A REAL KNOCKOUT bumped between horses and forced out at the start, chased inside, advanced outside a rival into the stretch, bid between horses in midstretch, could not match the winner and lost second late. END TUNE settled outside on the backstretch and four wide on the turn, came six wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. A LIL EXCESS angled in and stalked the pace on the backstretch, bid along the rail and dueled on the turn and to midstretch and weakened. HIGH BOLLY settled along the inside off the pace, came out a bit past midstretch and was not a threat. LIVELY LIZ close up stalking the pace outside, continued three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. CUT THE DEAL bumped and forced out between horses at the start, chased between foes on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and also weakened. SPRING TERM pulled her way to the front and angled in off the rail, dueled outside a rival on the turn, dropped back leaving the bend, drifted wide into the stretch and had little left. CATHY'S STAR broke a bit slowly and awkwardly then was slammed hard in a chain reaction and lost the rider. Following a stewards' inquiry, FIN LADY was disqualified and placed last for interference at the start.
