**Footnotes**

SPEED ROUSER had good early speed outside the runner-up then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and a bit off the fence into the stretch, fought back when headed and gamely prevailed while brushing with that rival late. NORWAY HOUSE had speed inside then was taken back leaving the first turn, stalked a bit off the rail, bid outside the winner on the second turn, put a head in front in upper stretch, brushed with that one and was outgamed. WILL stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch, loomed a threat behind the top pair in midstretch but could not quite summon the needed late kick three deep. WALTER RINGER chased between horses then a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn, came out past midstretch and lacked a further response. CHARADE EVENT was in a good position stalking the pace outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn and weakened. BEHREN DOWN bobbled a bit at the start, chased three deep on the first turn then outside a foe, steadied between horses nearing the stretch, drifted in and also weakened. SUNRISE EVENT saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally.
