**Footnotes**

SMOKIN' TEN between horses early, stalked three deep, bid three wide under urging into the stretch, gained the lead, inched away in midstretch and won clear. MARKET NOTES angled in and dueled three deep then outside a rival, battled between horses into the stretch, could not match the winner but held second. I'LL WRAP IT UP bobbled at the start, pulled his way along off the rail then between foes on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and three wide into the stretch and gained the show. UPTOWN BIG BROWN between foes early, angled in and stalked inside to the stretch and lacked the needed response. MR. CACTUS broke out onto a foe, chased outside then four wide on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. REDSTONE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ZOOKS a bit slow to begin, pulled between foes then outside a rival or a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and did not rally. DELI DUDE also broke a bit slowly, saved ground chasing the pace to the stretch and lacked a further response. TOSHEEN broke alertly but hopped and steadied when crowded between foes, had speed between rivals then stalked between horses, continued a bit off the rail on the turn, lugged in some in the stretch and weakened.
