DAISYAGO pulled a bit then settled just off the inside, moved up toward the rail on the second turn, came out into the stretch, lugged inward in midstretch but rallied under urging to prove best. WEED RUNNER stalked the pace outside a rival early, bid outside the leader and dueled on the backstretch and second turn and into the stretch, took a short lead nearing midstretch, fought back late but could not hold off the winner. MISTER PARTY had speed between horses then angled in, set a pressured pace inside, also fought back in the stretch and continued willingly to the wire. VILLA AMALFI broke slowly and awkwardly, settled inside, came out for the second turn and five wide into the stretch and put in a late bid outside. FIRST MESA angled in outside a rival early then a bit off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch and had a mild bid. WILLY'S WAY drifted out into the first turn, angled in and saved ground chasing the pace and lacked the needed rally. FREE PASS angled in and pulled his way along close up early, steadied in tight off heels on the first turn, saved ground stalking the pace and weakened. WILEY GREY close up stalking the leaders three deep on the first turn and backstretch, also weakened. FLEET STREET JACK came off the inside leaving the first turn, split horses on the backstretch, steadied while weakening on the second turn and dropped back. TRIALLITERATIONINDEX off slowly and awkwardly, settled outside a rival then off the rail and was done early.
