Footnotes

BIG SHAKESPEARE had good early speed and dueled three deep, inched away in the stretch and held gamely under urging. CRIMSON POLICY settled inside, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and closed willingly. DIPLOMATIC CORPS sent wide early, stalked the dueling leaders off the rail then outside leaving the turn, came three deep into the stretch and edged a foe for third. CINTTEGRITY saved ground chasing the pace, came out in the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and just missed the show. GUADALUPES TAILOR went up inside to duel for the lead to the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. CHAMPAGNE DAY settled a bit off the rail, drifted out on the turn, angled back in nearing the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BIG LEAGUE vied for command between horses to the stretch and weakened. TECH TWO sent between horses early, dropped back into the turn and weakened. SHOE'S PROSPECT sent between horses early, stalked outside, lugged out on the turn and had little left for the drive. GLOBAL GAIT allowed to settle wide on the backstretch, was carried out on the turn to come wide into the stretch, then collapsed and fell past the eighth pole.
