STAGE SHY stalked inside then was rank between horses through the stretch the first time, chased between foes then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the final turn, came out in upper stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch and pulled clear under some urging and good handling. COZIE ADVANTAGE stalked three deep, bid outside a rival on the backstretch, gained the advantage on the last turn, kicked clear into the stretch, could not match the winner but was second best. DAISYAGO went between foes into the stretch the first time, dueled outside a rival, took the lead and angled in on the backstretch, battled along the rail on the final turn and weakened but held third. ARABIC SONG (IRE) stalked inside, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally, then did not return to be unsaddled when bleeding from the nostrils and was vanned off. JOYFUL BALLAD chased a bit off the rail, went three deep on the final turn and into the stretch and did not rally. LADY THATCHER (CHI) took the early lead and set a pressured pace inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch and weakened.
