Footnotes

HONEST ANSWER a bit slow to begin, stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and rallied under urging to wear down the runner-up. DEVIOUS IMPACT had good early speed, angled in and dueled inside, shook free into the stretch and held on well but was worn down late. MIGHTY BAD NEWS chased a bit off the rail on the backstretch and along the inside on the turn, came out into the stretch and bested the others. SWEEP THE FIELD broke in the air and slowly, came out on the backstretch, split rivals approaching the turn, went three deep on the bend and wider into the stretch and could not sustain the bid in the stretch. BIG LIPS angled in and dueled outside a rival until nearing the stretch, then weakened. GOLDEN PENNY between horses early, dropped back on the backstretch, continued outside on the turn and wide into the stretch and was not a threat. MISS FREEDOM broke slowly, saved ground off the pace, moved up inside on the turn but lacked a further response. BAYOU BOOTS was in a good position chasing between horses, dropped back outside a rival on the turn and weakened. PERLA ERMOSA close up stalking off the rail, continued between horses on the turn and also weakened. ONE TWO PUNCH unhurried outside on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn and was outrun.
