DUBLINO settled inside, went outside ARABIC SONG into and on the second turn, came out in midstretch and closed gamely under urging to prove narrowly best. MEGAHERTZ (GB) saved ground unhurried early, came a bit off the rail and moved up some on the second turn, came out a bit in the stretch, split rivals past midstretch and finished with a rush toward the inside. ALOZAINA (IRE) stalked the leader a bit off the rail, bid outside that one leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, gained a short lead in the stretch, inched away past midstretch, could not match the top pair but held third. FAIR BIANCA took the early lead and angled to the inside leaving the chute, set the pace along the rail, fought back when challenged on the second turn and in the stretch but weakened late. ARABIC SONG (IRE) angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, remained inside and lacked the needed late response. RISTRA chased outside a rival most of the way to the second turn, continued off the inside, came out into the stretch and weakened.
