By subscription of \$300 each, which shall accompany the nomination, \$1,000 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$180,000 to first, \$60,000 to second, \$36,000 to third, \$18,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. First preference will be given to graded or group stakes winners. Second preference will be given to fillies which have finished second or third in graded or group stakes. Total non-claiming purse earnings will determine the order of preference for fillies of equal status. Nominations closed Thursday, August 14, 2003 with 17. (Rail at 7 feet).

DESSERT sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the second turn, kicked clear again past the eighth pole and held gamely under urging. SOLAR ECHO broke out a bit, stalked outside a rival then between horses into the second turn, continued just off the rail leaving that bend, came out in the stretch and bumped with CASSIS, then finished well to just miss. PERSONAL LEGEND chased inside then outside a rival leaving the second turn, came out in the stretch and rallied late for third. CASSIS stalked outside a rival or off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, bumped with the runner-up in midstretch and continued willingly between foes at the wire. ATLANTIC OCEAN stalked the winner off the rail, bid outside that one on the second turn and into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. STAR VEGA (GB) was in a good position chasing the pace along the inside, remained on the rail and lacked the needed response. KATDOGAWN (GB) unhurried inside then outside a rival, came out some in the stretch and lacked a rally, then was not urged late. WELL DONE MY LOVE (GER) angled in and saved ground off the pace and did not rally.
