Footnotes

KAFISTER bumped at the start, had speed between foes to duel for the lead, inched away early on the turn, dueled inside on the turn, kicked clear in the stretch and proved best under left handed urging. JONES DESTINY prompted the pace between foes then stalked between horses on the turn, came three wide into the stretch, split rivals in midstretch, drifted in and was second best. EKAHI broke in and bumped a rival, settled off the rail, came out four wide into the stretch and gained the show late. DUKE STREET KING sent between horses early, steadied and dropped back midway on the backstretch, continued off the rail, came five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. TRICE UP between foes early, chased off the rail, came out leaving the turn and five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SEXYUKNOWIT bumped at the break, pressed the pace three deep between foes then outside the winner on the turn and weakened in the stretch. KENTUCKY KID between rivals early, settled off the inside then outside a rival on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. SHOER HUGH a bit slow into stride, was sent along inside to press the pace, stalked along the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. VALLEY SPIRIT had speed off the rail then angled in, pressed the pace four wide, stalked three deep on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch, steadied in tight off heels nearing midstretch while weakening and dropped back.
