LET'S GO CHEYENNE tugged her way to the early lead between foes, angled in on the first turn, set the pace along the inside, opened up through the stretch the first time, shifted out a bit into the final turn, drifted out in the final furlong and won clear under urging. LEFT A MESSAGE chased outside a rival then inside on the clubhouse turn and backstretch, continued inside on the last turn, came out some in the stretch, split rivals a sixteenth out and got up for second. THISISMYSTAGE saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and again in midstretch, was four wide a sixteenth out and held third. QUAINLY chased inside then a bit off the rail on the last turn and in the stretch, was between foes in deep stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. LADY ASPEN angled in and saved ground off the pace, continued inside on the last turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. CHASIN PERFECTION pulled three deep early, chased outside a rival or off the rail, continued alongside a foe on the final turn, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. WARREN'S GOT GAME tugged three deep then chased outside a rival, went three wide leaving the final turn and into the stretch and lacked a rally.
