ECONOMY OF MOTION sped to the early lead off the rail, angled in and set the pace inside, inched away on the turn, drew off under urging in the stretch and was under a long hold late. QIAONA chased between horses then off the rail, angled in on the turn, came out in midstretch and got up for a share of

second four wide on the line. ONLY JOSIE KNOWS stalked four wide to the stretch, continued outside in midstretch and shared the place between horses late. IT'S AINE stalked between rivals on the backstretch and turn, continued between foes in midstretch and was edged for a minor award between horses on the line. TRIBAL CUSTOM broke a bit slowly then steadied when shut off, moved up inside to chase the pace, came out into the stretch, went around a rival nearing midstretch then angled to the rail late and was edged for a minor share. ITALIAN HARMONY a bit slow to begin, was sent between rivals then stalked outside a foe, continued a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened, then was in a bit tight off heels at the end. WARREN'S SUGARBUZZ settled outside then off the rail, went outside a rival on the turn and lacked the needed rally. MUNA JEWELS broke a bit slowly, went up inside to stalk the pace on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the drive. MEMO TO MAGGIE broke out onto a foe, stalked between horses then dropped back a bit off the rail on the turn and also weakened. RUTHLESLEE between foes early, dropped back and angled in, came out in upper stretch and was not a threat.
