Footnotes

HUSTLIN NU had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, took the lead nearing the stretch, inched clear a bit off the rail under urging in the drive and held gamely. LEGAL SEPARATION bumped at the start, between horses early then settled toward the inside, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and gained the place. IT DOESN'T ADD UP stalked four wide on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and bested the rest. ALWAYS THE SAME stalked between horses, was in a bit tight early on the turn, continued just off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked a rally. CHIBITA saved ground stalking the pace, came off the rail in the stretch and lacked the necessary response. PACK YOUR BAGS chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn and weakened. LOVE THAT ACTION bumped at the start, settled inside, saved ground on the turn, remained inside in the stretch and was not a threat, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. TWO VIOLINS dueled outside the winner on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. NORTHERN POPTART crowded just after the start, pulled and steadied in the early going, chased

outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and did not rally. BUDS PAL bumped at the start, was between horses chasing the pace then a bit off the rail on the turn and was not a threat. RAETODANDTY squeezed between foes just after the start, settled outside a rival, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. TEASING BERNIE bobbed a bit at the start, settled off the rail, angled to the inside on the turn and was not a factor.
