APPEALING RESUME chased outside then three deep into and on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside in midstretch, gained the lead and held gamely under urging. INNER GROOVE chased off the rail then inside on the turn, came out and bid between horses in midstretch, was bumped nearing the sixteenth pole and continued willingly. ALWAYS A CHANCE broke slowly, settled inside, came out on the turn and seven wide into the stretch and closed willingly. BROOKLYN ROSE settled outside then off the rail, went four wide leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and found her best stride late. ADDENDUM stalked a bit off the rail or between horses, split rivals leaving the turn as the rider lost the whip, came out in the stretch, bid between foes in midstretch, was bumped nearing the sixteenth marker and was outfinished. SO SHE DANCES stalked early then bid inside leaving the backstretch, dueled for the lead, fought back a bit off the rail in the stretch, was bumped and forced inward nearing the sixteenth marker and weakened. SHE'S ALL YOURS had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then between foes, battled outside a rival on the turn, fought back between horses in midstretch and also weakened some late. SECRET GENIUS settled a bit off the rail then inside, saved ground on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. YOUTHEPRIZEANDI chased outside then off the rail, angled in a bit off the fence on the turn and did not rally, then was vanned off after being walked part of the way back to being unsaddled. SLEEP TIGHT stalked outside then three deep on the turn, came out six wide into the stretch and weakened. WOEBEGON dueled outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch, dropped back leaving the turn, drifted five wide into the stretch, gave way and was eased.
