ADANCE sent between horses early, dueled inside, put a head in front on the turn, inched away under urging past midstretch and held gamely. NICOLE AND BEN stalked the early pace outside then bid outside foes on the backstretch, tracked the dueling leaders on the turn and finished willingly for the place. QUARTERLY REPORT off a bit slowly, settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, moved up inside on the turn, came a bit off the fence in the stretch, drifted back inward in deep stretch and gained the show on the rail. NEVER EVER sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled between horses then outside the winner on the turn and until past midstretch and weakened some but lost third late. KLEVEN'S VERBATIM settled inside, saved ground throughout to no avail. MATTY G WHIZ chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. COURT SEEKER chased between horses on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn and weakened.
