

Footnotes

CANDY FACTORY chased a bit off the rail, came out on the final turn and split horses four wide, went three deep into the stretch, gained the lead past the eighth pole and drew clear under some urging. SUNNY DISPOSITION sped between foes to the lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, opened up through the stretch the first time, responded when rivals loomed on the last turn, could not match the winner but held second. AUBONNE (GER) chased outside a rival then between foes on the final turn, came out some in the stretch and edged a rival for third. TAHTHEEB (IRE) chased outside, went three deep into the final turn and five wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. SOHGOL (IRE) stalked inside or a bit off the rail, was outside a rival on the last turn and weakened in the stretch. MEMORETTE chased outside a rival then between foes, was three deep between rivals on the final turn and also weakened. IMMORTALITE (PER) saved ground chasing the pace, continued inside and did not rally. LATE DATE stalked inside then outside a rival, went between foes on the final turn and had little left for the stretch. ARABIC DANCER chased outside then three deep, went four wide on the second turn, dropped back leaving the backstretch, angled in for the final turn and gave way.
