COLUDA had speed outside foes then angled in on the first turn and set the pace inside, inched away leaving the second turn and drew off in the stretch under urging. STRAIGHTOMIDNIGHT chased a bit off the rail then outside into the second turn, continued three deep leaving that turn and into the stretch and just held second between foes late. SUFI DANCER settled outside a rival, went three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch and just got the show three wide on the line. SELF MADE broke a bit slowly, was sent along inside then tugged some under a hold, split rivals leaving the second turn, angled to the inside in the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. SKY'SQUICKSCORE pulled along the inside and was in tight into the first turn, stalked along the rail or a bit off the fence, continued inside on the second turn and weakened. MINISTERS POWER also pulled his way along and steadied into the first turn, went up three deep on the backstretch and into the second turn, continued between foes leaving that turn and had little left for the stretch. FIRE IN THE WIND three deep early, stalked outside, dropped back between foes on the second turn, gave way and was not persevered with in the final furlong.
