Footnotes

HIDDEN QUEST dueled between horses, put a head in front in the stretch, drifted out under left then right handed urging in deep stretch and held gamely. CHICAGO HERO angled in and dueled three deep, fought back in the stretch, was floated out in deep stretch but continued gamely five wide between foes on the line. MAVENOFWINTERSET hesitated to be away behind the field, dropped well back inside, came out on the turn and six wide into the stretch and

rallied seven wide on the line. DR. NIP stalked inside, came out into the stretch, waited momentarily then split horses nearing the wire in a game try. STORMIN ARVIN chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and split foes six wide on the line. MIDNIGHT RAVEN settled off the rail then inside, came out a bit in the stretch, was in tight nearing the wire then squeezed between horses on the line. MINISTER OF TRADE had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back through the stretch and was outfinished. ARIZONA WILDCAT between foes early, stalked three deep, split rivals leaving the turn, was three wide into the stretch and weakened. FALCON'S THRONE chased five wide on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch and did not rally. ANABAA'S BLUFF settled wide then well off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, continued inside on the turn and failed to menace. FINEGAN AGAIN chased four wide on the backstretch and turn and into the stretch and weakened.
