MISS PIXIE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail, drifted out slightly in the stretch and held on gamely under urging. ELDERBERRY saved ground chasing the winner, came out a bit past the quarter pole and again into the stretch and finished well to just miss. CAPITAL REQUEST pulled hard stalking the pace a bit off the rail, found the fence in the stretch and continued gamely along the rail to the wire. MAURICIENNE (FR) off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground unhurried, cut the corner into the stretch, then came out in midstretch and split foes with a late bid. TINDARI MARIA (FR) settled outside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ISLAY MIST (GB) chased outside a foe on the first turn and backstretch, continued outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. BURNING HOPE stalked the pace outside a rival after going three deep into the first turn, came three deep into the stretch and had little left. CANDACE IN PARIS saved ground off the pace, moved up toward the inside on the second turn, split rivals leaving the turn, then clipped heels past the quarter pole and fell. Following a stewards' inquiry, ELDERBERRY was disqualified and placed last for interference leaving the second turn.
