For horses not nominated, supplementary nominations of \$10,000 each will close at the time of entry, Friday, August 24, 2001. All horses shall pay \$500 to pass the entry box and \$2,000 additional to start. Weight 121 lbs.; Non-winners of \$40,000 twice allowed 2 lbs.; of such a race, 4 lbs.; of \$15,000 other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs.; of a race other than claiming, 8 lbs. Closed with 146 nominations, one supplement.

Footnotes

HABIBTI off a bit slowly, was taken a bit off the rail early, pulled her way between horses leaving the backstretch and early on the turn, angled in on the bend, awaited room leaving the turn then got through into the stretch, bid inside rivals and gained a short lead in midstretch, then pulled clear under some urging and steady handling. WHO LOVES ALEYNA took the early lead outside then dueled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn, battled three deep into the stretch, regained the advantage briefly in midstretch, could not match the winner but held second. TEMPERA stalked the early leader toward the inside, bid inside that one and put a head in front nearing the turn, dueled a bit off the rail on the bend and between rivals into the stretch and to midstretch but weakened late. QUE BONITA chased outside then three deep nearing the turn and lacked a late response. LIL MISS HOLLYWOOD saved ground chasing the pace, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened.
