BELLESKI stalked outside a rival, came out in upper stretch, rallied under left handed urging while lugging in to gain the lead and pulled clear. MARKET GARDEN stalked the pace three deep then off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter into the stretch, gained a short lead in upper stretch but could not hold off the winner. FENCELINEINEIGHBOR pulled toward the inside then drifted out into the first turn, angled in and chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and was edged for second. FINAL DISCOUNT sped to the early lead, angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, fought back in midstretch but weakened late. REEFS SIS (GB) forced out into the first turn, angled in and moved up inside leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. WESTERN VIEW pulled her way along inside to stalk the pace to the stretch and weakened. BARTOK'S BLITHE forced out into the first turn, chased outside a rival, dropped far back leaving the backstretch and on the second turn and was eased in the stretch.
